(a) $f(x) = x^3 - 2x + 50$

(b) $f(x) = x^{100} - 1$

(c) $f(x) = x^2 - x + 1$

(d) $f(x) = x^{61} - x^{50} + x + 4$

Given the following information, approximate $f(4)$ and $f(2)$

(a) $f(3) = 2, f'(3) = -1$

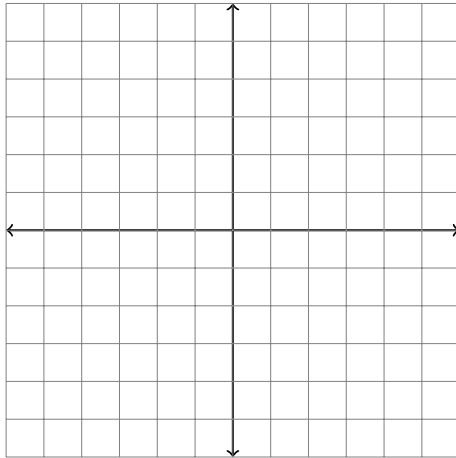
(b) $f(3) = 100, f'(3) = 9$

(c) $f(5) = 10, f'(5) = -1$

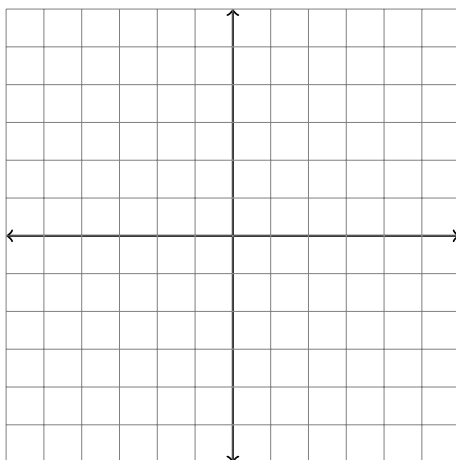
(d) $f(1) = 1, f'(1) = 0$

(b) $f(1) = 0, f'(1) = 3, f'(2) = -1$



(c) $f(0) = 0, f'(1) = 4, f'(2) = 2, f'(3) = 0, f'(4) = -2, f'(5) = -4$
